2. KLIPSCH HEADPHONES

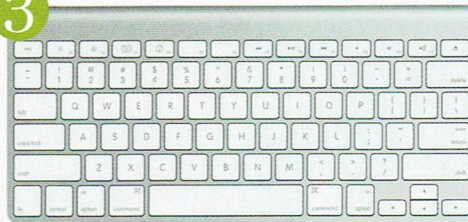
